Clutch Release Bearing

MODELS:

MG Midget

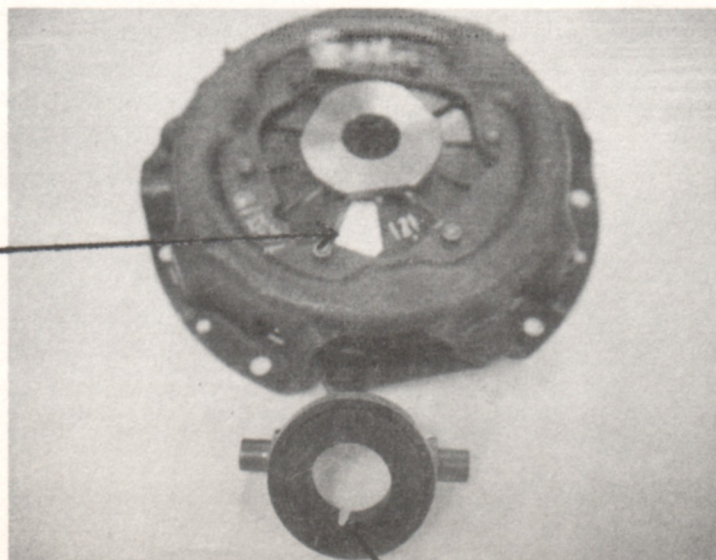
Commencing at serial number GAN5U111496, a revised material for the clutch release bearing, part number GRB107, was incorporated. The new bearing can be identified by a groove or a ridge in the internal diameter of the carbon.

In addition, a reduced clamping load on the clutch assembly was introduced, identified by buff colored paint on the release fingers, instead of blue paint for the present assembly. The new release bearing can be used with either clutch assembly.

The performance of this new bearing will be closely monitored, therefore, any claims for this component under warranty after the serial number concerned, must be accompanied by the parts.
