TRIM HEIGHTS

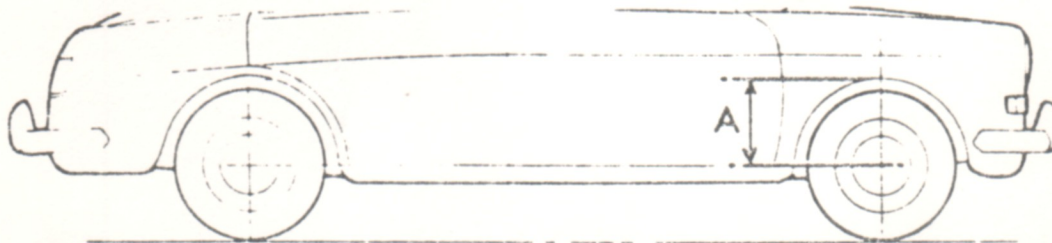
MODELS:

ALL MODELS FITTED WITH
HYDROLASTIC SUSPENSION

The following data applies to cars where the suspension has 'settled' normally, no action should be taken to alter trim heights unless there is evidence of fluid loss or mechanical failure.

Checking must be carried out with full oil and water content plus 4 gallons (18.30 litres, 5 3/4 US gallons) of petrol. Any equipment other than standard should be removed.

The vehicle should be rocked transversely, with effort applied at the top of the 'B' post before measuring trim heights.
