SUPPLEMENTARY INFORMATION TO SECTIONS B-4 (ISSUE 1) AND B-6 (ISSUE 1)

Modified Drive Assemblies

During 1960 a modification was introduced to plate clutch drive assemblies, involving the reversal of the order of the inner and outer clutch plates, and the introduction of a support plate between the flange of the moving member and the first clutch plate.

The required amendments to the Sections, in order to meet these modifications, are as follows:-




Fig. 9 Exploded view of Plate Clutch Drive

SECTION B-4, Issue 1, Page 6, Fig. 9 becomes :

"Place the Backing Ring, Clutch Plates, Support Plate, Moving Member (E) and Retaining Washer (K) on the core, in that order".




Fig. 9 Starter Drive, Dismantled

SECTION B-6, Issue 1, Page 7, Fig. 9 becomes :
